私は 2004 年に Cocktail「Chairperson」を創作しました、日本人の内科医・医学博士である志田幸久と申します。

ご参考までに私の専門分野「Sports と医学教育」におきましては、日本医学教育学会の錦織宏理事長も裏金に関して甘く、裏口大学、裏口医師に対して弱腰で見えます一方、国立名古屋大学大学院（国立名古屋大学の学科試験合格）、英国 Dundee 大学大学院、そして蘭国 Maastricht 大学大学院を卒業された秀才です。裏金（医学生、医師、大学、学会、Mass Media にて非公開の医学教育費一寄附金、学債）は一般に 1,000 万円超で、（偏差値の平均 50 なかった）新谷正義議員の裏金も一切非公開です。
